KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT we, the undersigned, all citizens of Texas, under and by virtue of the laws of this State, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves for the purpose of forming a private corporation under such laws upon the following terms and conditions:

I.

The name of the corporation shall be "McALLEN CITIZENS LEAGUE."

II.

The purpose for which it is formed is to support an educational undertaking as authorized by Subdivision 2 of Article 1302 of Texas Revised Civil Statutes of 1925, in this, that the purpose is to educate the citizenry of McAllen, Texas, by sponsoring prominent lectures on current affairs. This will include open forum discussions of civics, history and other recognized courses of study as applied to the problems of the day. Special attention will be given to problems of juvenile delinquencies. This corporation will not attempt to influence legislation and is non-political in nature.

III.

The place where the business of the corporation is to be conducted and transacted is in the City of McAllen in Hidalgo County, Texas, in accordance with the laws of said State, and its principal place of business is to be in the said City of McAllen in said Hidalgo County, Texas.

IV.

The term for which it is to exist is twenty (20) years.

V.


The number of directors shall be as fixed by the By-Laws of the corporation, and until changed by the By-Laws, shall be three (3), and the names and residences of those who are appointees for the first year are as follows:



This corporation is to be organized without capital stock, is to continue without capital stock, and at the present time owns no property.



TO THE
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Pursuant to the provisions of Article 4.03 of the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation which:

Extend the duration of the corporation to perpetual.

1. The name of the corporation is McAllen Citizens League.
2. The following amendment to the Articles of Incorporation was adopted by the corporation on the 25th day of May, 1972.

Article IV of the Articles of Incorporation is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

3. The amendment was adopted in the following manner:

"The amendment was adopted at a meeting of members held on May 25, 1972, at which a quorum was present, and the amendment received at least two-thirds of the votes which members present or represented by proxy at such meeting were entitled to cast."
